**District Accountability:**

The overall accountability status for the Hannibal Central School District is “Good Standing” for the 2008-09 school year as reported by the New York State District Report Card.

Our district remains on the “Contract For Excellence” list for the 2009 – 2010 school year due to the following:

- The High School was identified as a “School in Need of Improvement Year 2” last year. The High School made adequate yearly progress (AYP) this year. This indicates that this school made satisfactory progress toward the goal of proficiency for all students. It is required that a school make AYP two consecutive years to be removed from the “School in Need of Improvement Year 2” status. If the High School makes AYP next year, this school will be a school in “good standing.”
- The Kenney Middle School was identified as a “School in Need of Improvement Year 1” last year. The Kenney Middle School did not make adequate yearly progress (AYP) this year, so that school is identified as a “School in Need of Improvement Year 2.”

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*Contract requirement for the 2009 – 2010 school year*

*Any district that was subject to Contract for Excellence in 2008-2009 will be required to submit a Contract in 2009-2010, unless all of their schools are in good standing. In the Hannibal Central School District, the Kenney Middle School and the Hannibal High School are both Schools in Need of Improvement - Year 2. Therefore the Hannibal Central School District is required to submit a Contract in 2009-2010.*

*Maintenance of Effort (MOE) Amount*

*The State budget provides Foundation Aid for all school districts at the 2008-09 level. The law requires Contract for Excellence districts to maintain expenditures for C4E allowable programs at the level of their 2007-08 and 2008-09 C4E Contract Amounts, as approved by the Commissioner. NYSED has calculated the 2008-09 approved Contract Amount including 2007-08 maintenance of effort amounts, to be the 2009-10 Contract for Excellence Maintenance of Effort amount for the Hannibal Central School District to be \$1,636,080.*

## *Reallocation of Funds*

The reallocation of funds can support new or expanded Contract for Excellence allowable programs. Reallocated funds are accounted for in the 2009-2010 Contract for Excellence year, and are not part of the prior year's Maintenance of Effort.

Money for this year's Contract may be spent on supporting losses to other existing programs such as Reading First. If grant funds are reduced or eliminated for programs that fit within the Contract for Excellence allowable programs, such as reading initiatives that could be described as additional Time on Task, it is possible to use C4E-restricted funds to support losses to existing programs with C4E reallocated funds.

The Hannibal Central School District has experienced a severe reduction in Reading First funding for the 2009-2010 school year. Our district will reallocate C4E funds to support our reading first initiatives and sustained literacy. The amount to be reallocating is \$
